THE RIGHT REVEREND *J. L. Jackson*

Bishop J. L. Jackson was born on April 1st, 1984 in Raleigh, North Carolina. In 1993, his family relocated to Roanoke, Virginia after residing in Danville, VA for several years.

Educated within the Roanoke City Public Schools System, Bishop Jackson went on to achieve academic excellence by continuing his educational studies at the John Tyler Mortuary School, the Aeon Bible College, the Rovear Christian University, and the Rehoboth Bible College. He holds Doctorate of Divinity degree in Pastoral Ministry from the Word of Life Theological Seminary.

Having been called to the ministry almost three decades ago, he began his work for the kingdom at the early age of twelve under the leadership of his father, Suffragan-

Bishop Delmar Jackson, II. In 2000 he was licensed for ministry by the Virginia State Council (Apostolic), Inc. In 2010, he was licensed as an Elder, in 2013 he was Ordained.

In the year 2000, Bishop Jackson founded J. L. Jackson Ministries (JLJ Ministries), a Ministry that is focused on bringing sincerity in serving God. The Ministry is delivered through five basic ministry focus points: Preaching, Evangelism, Prayer, Leadership Training and Mentorship.

From 2003 to 2013, he served the Virginia State Council Apostolic, Inc. and the Pentecostal Assemblies of the World, Inc. as the Assistant to the Young People's President, the elected State Young People's President of Virginia, the International Assistant Teen Director for the International Pentecostal Young Peoples Union (PAW, Inc.), as well as the International Teen Director.

Beginning in 2009, Pastor Jackson served the Abundant Grace Assembly of Roanoke, Virginia with his Father as the Executive Pastor and Overseer of Ecclesiastical Ministries. In the Summer of 2013, He was assigned to serve as the Interim Pastor of Bethesda Temple of the Apostolic Faith in Washington, DC, where he continued until his assignment was accomplished. In October of 2015, Pastor Jackson launched OutPour Church in Martinsville, VA. In January of 2018, Bishop and a ministry team from OutPour started a Bible Study in the city of Roanoke, VA, called ReFresh Roanoke. For one year, the ministry grew and souls were added to the family of believers. In January of 2019, the two ministries (OutPour Church and ReFresh Roanoke) merged together and were relocated, renamed, and relaunched in the city of Roanoke, VA, as ReFreshing Church. ReFreshing Church serves as a community-based Church Connecting People, ReFreshing Faith, and Serving Others.

Additionally, Bishop Jackson is an active member of his community as a Community Advocate. He has served as a City Youth Services Citizens Board. He presently serves as the Lead Community Engagement Chaplain for the Roanoke City Sheriff's Office, a registered Chaplain for the Clerk of Circuit Courts, and a City Council Appointed member of the Roanoke Neighborhood Advocates Board, and a City Council Appointed member of the City of Roanoke Task Force to Reduce Gun Violence. Globally, Bishop served as the Dean of the Adjutants Academy and a member of the Advisory Board for the Joint College of African American Pentecostal Bishops in Cleveland, Ohio, with Archbishop J. Delano Ellis, II. In 2015, he was appointed to work as an Overseer, and later Consecrated on June 20, 2018, as a Bishop in the Lord's Church by the Late Bishop Alphonso Scott. He can be seen working to impact this world in whatever way possible.

J. L. Jackson is the loving husband to the Queen of his life, Lady Porshia Jackson, and together they have three amazing princesses, Little Miss Alexia Nicole, Little Miss Grace Annette and Little Miss Caroline Denise.

Above all, Bishop J. L. Jackson is simply a man in pursuit of the heart and mind of God who has been called out to declare a word into the lives of the people of God, and it is his hope and desire that through his ministry you are able to sense his love for Christ and that you feel compelled to strengthen your relationship with God.

The following information is being provided to help you in hosting and preparing for Bishop J. L. Jackson's Ministry visit to your ministry. He is VERY low maintenance and easy to be served. If you are unsure about anything just ask him. Thank you in advance for your care, kindness, and gracious hospitality towards Bishop Jackson.

Ministry Style:

Bishop Jackson has an extreme passion for delivering the Word of God so that souls will be saved, people will be encouraged, and lives will be changed. Because of his vast preaching experience, he understands that all ministries are uniquely different. We simply ask that you brief us on your belief system, doctrine, service structure, preaching time and proper attire for ministry. Bishop Jackson believes in regarding order and submission to Pastoral leadership, these components will ensure that the ministry moment is as effective as possible.

Honorarium:

Bishop Jackson has been ministry for close to three decades and has become accustomed to receiving an honorarium commensurate to the ministry that has been provided and we trust that you will honor the anointing on his life. We request that your ministry prepare an honorarium of at least \$1200.00, per service or session, for Bishop Jackson. For instructional sessions and ceremonial occasions, please contact our office for honorarium specifics. We ask that the honoraria be given to Bishop Jackson upon arrival or right after ministry on the day of the engagement. These funds must be tendered via check or certified funds. Personal checks will not be accepted.

Because financial gain is not the aim of J. L. Jackson Ministries, if the requested gift cannot be met, please submit a proposed budget to us so that all parties involved can come to a respectable medium.

Food and Beverages:

Bishop is very low maintenance. He prefers room temperature water and at times 100% juice while he is ministering. He prefers not to do a lot of eating at various restaurants before or after services. Bishop does, at times, request fresh fruit in his room to eat between services and while staying in your city; however, large baskets that aren't able to be packaged for travel are unnecessary.

Travel (Driving):

If your event location is more than 1 hour of driving time, **we do ask** that you send a travel stipend using the current standard IRS mileage rate to and from your event location. This should be sent at least one week prior to the event.

Travel (Flying):

Bishop Jackson does not have a preferred airline. Our office will handle the scheduling of travel arrangements for both Bishop Jackson and his ministry travel assistant. The sponsoring ministry shall be responsible for the purchase of Two (2) full unrestricted airline tickets. Please use the following airport or station (Amtrak) when booking his travel itinerary: Roanoke Regional Airport (ROA). Please call or e-mail us BEFORE you finalize the purchase of tickets.

Ground Transportation:

Car and driver for the Exclusive/Private use of Bishop Jackson and his traveling assistant throughout the duration of his stay and ministerial obligations with your ministry must provide all Ground Transportation services. (I.e. pick up to and from airport, to and from hotel, to and from venue, etc.) Please note Bishop Jackson does not require private rental nor luxury vehicles and limousines, but please ensure assigned personnel and or vehicles from your ministry are presentable for the ministry guest.

Note: Bishop Jackson prefers to be picked up by at least one *brother* to represent your ministry upon his arrival. All ground transportation providers must be waiting the arrival of Bishop Jackson and his travel assistant in baggage claim with a sign indicating Bishop J. L. Jackson's name for pick-up. Most times he travels in a black suit and clerical collar and should be easy to identify.

Furthermore, JL Jackson Ministries must be provided with full contact information of the ground transportation, including but not limited to full name, cell phone number, company's name, and confirmation number (if applicable), at least 48 hours prior to scheduled arrival to city.

Hotels:

Bishop Jackson does not request or require a specific hotel for lodging; however, we ask that the hotel be at least a 3 Star hotel to ensure comfort during his stay. Bishop Jackson requests 1 non-smoking king room for him and 1 non-smoking king room for his travel assistant.

Other helpful tips:

When providing hospitality to the man of God, his personal preference is that he *NOT* be directly served independently by the *sisters* of your ministry (i.e. Adjutant Sisters and Female Armor bearers).

While ministering Bishop Jackson prefers that the air condition and/or fans be turned **OFF**, especially in the pulpit area. He understands that at times this may inconvenience the congregants, if this is the case, then please turn the air condition on low fan.

Bishop Jackson loves people! He will usually want to shake hands with congregants after the service is over. Please allow a few minutes for him to do so if at all possible. After ministering he will need to change clothes immediately as he is usually extremely wet. Please have two copies of the audio and or video in CD and/ or DVD format, ready upon his departure.
